#### Educational Leadership, Masters of Science

The MSEL Program is designed for current and aspiring administrators who desire to build a theoretical understanding of effective leadership and develop practical skills in educational administration. Graduates are recommended to the State of MI and are eligible for the State of MI K-12 Building Administrator Certificate. Typical completion time is about 2 years.

- Online or seated on Saturdays, Opportunity to start every 8 weeks
- 10 courses + 2 credit internship = 32 credits

#### Curriculum and Instruction, Masters of Science

Broaden your own education as you study curriculum design, teaching theories, and more. Graduates seek professions such as instructional coordinators, as well as assist and develop curriculum and work with school administration to improve instruction. This program encourages educators to become master teachers and remain in the classroom.

- Online or seated, Opportunity to start every 8 weeks
- 10 courses + 1 credit portfolio development = 31 credits
- Typical completion time: 2 years

#### Special Education Learning Disabilities, Masters of Science or Endorsement

Learn real-world skills for addressing the needs of students with learning disabilities. Students must pass the MI Test of Teacher Competence for Special Education (MTTC). Courses meet in 8-week sessions.

- Online, now accepting applications for Fall 2016 start
- 9 core courses + 2 research = 36 credits (Students in the endorsement program take the 9 core courses.)
- Typical completion time: 2 years for the Master's program and 18 months for the endorsement program.

#### Student Personnel Administration in Higher Education, Masters of Science

The SPAHE program is designed for those who want to work in higher education doing roles such as athletic director or student life staff. Students choose a track of either administration or athletics. Typical completion is about 2 years.

- Seated, next seated program begins August 2016
- 11 courses + 1, 1-credit, research course = 34 credits

#### School Administrator Certificate Program, Certificate Program

The SACP Program is designed for current and aspiring administrators who already have their Master's degree and desire to build a theoretical understanding of effective leadership and develop practical skills in school administration. Graduates are recommended to the State of Michigan for the K-12 Building Administrator Certificate. Typical completion time is < than 2 years.

- Online or seated on Saturdays, Opportunity to start every 8 weeks
- 7 courses + 2 credit internship = 23 credits

#### English as a Second Language, Endorsement (NS)

Designed for those who want to gain the skills necessary for addressing the needs of limited English proficient students in grades K-12, candidates apply knowledge in classroom situations beginning with the understanding of different cultures, and move to a deeper learning of English linguistics and grammar. Graduates who pass the MI Test for Teacher Certification in English as a Second Language obtain the Michigan Endorsement in the area of English as a Second Language (NS). Typical completion time is about one year.

#### **State Required Reading Course**

In 2009, the State of Michigan required completion of a 3-credit reading course on the diagnosis and remediation of reading disabilities and differentiated instruction. Required for all teachers applying for the Professional Teaching Certificate, both courses are offered online every 8 weeks and in-person in July.

- EDU540/840 Strategies for Struggling Readers & Writers in the Elementary Classroom (3 credits)
- EDU545/845 Teaching for Struggling Readers & Writers in the Secondary Classroom (3 credits)
